

## Woodland Elks Support "Project Play"

In the early morning hours of July 16, 2007, a suspected arson fire destroyed a portion of the children's play structure at John Ferns Park Playground. This playground is the most widely used playground in Woodland. A committee was formed to rebuild the structure. It was decided by the committee that the children of Woodland should have a say in the reconstruction of the play structure. After meeting with the children, the committee decided that no child should be disappointed and thus a list of playground equipment was created.



The rebuild is will take place beginning October 31 and concluding on November 4. Costs for the structure is higher than originally anticipated due to the increased size of the structure. The city feels that the insurance company will not cover the entire cost and will cover only the cost of the original design. It is estimated that the cost to rebuild the playground will be between \$118,000 and \$120,000. The shortfall will have to be raised through private and corporate donations. Donations can be made in any amount, or by purchasing a tile for \$100.






