



The Woodland Elks No. 1299 recently donated \$1,000 to Jim Rodgers, Executive Director of the Yolo Family Service Agency, to help provide counseling for individuals and families without health insurance.

The \$1,000 was raised through the Elks' "Monday Night Bingo" held each Monday night from 6 to 10 p.m.

Woodland Elks Exalted Ruler Brian Flemmer and Elks Bingo Chairman Jim Fuller delivered the check to Jim Rodgers, executive director of YFSA.

"Counseling helps alleviate the innumerable stressors that can lead families to be dysfunctional and produce irrational behavioral in children," Rodgers said. "YFSA's low income counseling service has been proven to prevent child abuse and reduce the number of families requiring intervention from Child Protective Services."

Fuller said the Elk's Monday Night Bingo is the only bingo game in Woodland and invited the public to experience a fun time while raising money for charities.

"The public is welcome to join us in our mission," he said.

The Order of Elks is dedicated to service to communities and the country with emphasis on those who are less fortunate and in need. It is also dedicated to the youth, veteran's services, furtherance of Americanism and many other benevolent activities.

The Woodland Elks Lodge, located on Bush and College Streets in Woodland since 1924, discounts the use of its hall to non profits and sponsors special event. The Lodge also sponsors scholarships for up to nine students.
