We will be starting our TEXAS HOLD'EM POKER TOURNAMENTS on Saturday, September 19th. The tournaments will all start at 12 noon and end no later than 4pm. We have made some changes from last year. First, we are eliminating the \$ 5.00 chips. The minimum chip will be \$25.00. This will speed things up a little . To compensate we are increasing the amount of chips the players will receive from \$1500.00 to \$2000.00. The price of a buy-in will remain at \$10.00 with the chance to make a second buy-in with in the first hour of play. Prize money will be awarded depending on the amount of players in each tournament. 
