## YOUNTVILLE BBQ FOR VETERANS

Aug 12, 2017 the North Central District (NCD) had its annual BBQ for the Veterans at the Yountville Veterans Hospital. The NCD consist of 9 lodges: Carmichael 2103, Elk Grove 2577, Jackson 783, Rancho Cordova 2484, Roseville 2248, Sacramento 6, Placerville 1712 and Woodland 1299.

The Yountville Veterans Facility located in the Napa Valley, is the oldest facility's in the United States being opened in 1884 and serviced Mexican War and Civil War Veterans.

All the Lodge contribute to make this a very successful operation. We fed about 300 Veteran patients, staff and our own volunteers. Because many of the Patients are in wheel chairs we arrange to help transport them to the BBQ, our members then take their orders and serve them.

Our Lodges also contribute boxes of clothing, books and pillows. **A special thanks to our biggest contributor the Woodland Elks, Emblem Club that has collected clothing for the entire year to contribute to this event.**

The Elk Grove Ladies Antlerettes contributed Travel Pillows with Handmade pillow cases. The handmade pillow cases were very popular and did not last long. One Veteran in a wheel chair was ecstatic when he saw a pillow case with Route 66 theme. He just had to show us his license on his wheel chair which read, Route 66.

We are happy to report no one left hungry and we already have a date schedule for next year.
