Woodland Elks

Lodge member and Veterans Committee Chairman Romeo Losoya is shown. Romeo has been a member of the Woodland Elks Lodge for 55 years. A Navy veteran who served in the Korean war aboard the USS Saipan and the USS Midway from 1952 to 1956 as a Radioman 2nd Class. Romeo saw action in the Pacific, Atlantic, Far East, the Mediterranean, the Yellow Sea, the China Sea and Indian Ocean. He developed and installed a wonderful veterans wall of pictures that include individual stories that highlights more than 70+ veterans, who were also Woodland Elk members. Romeo's own navy picture from 1952, is the first one in the second row inside the wall frame. The Elks Lodge memorial also includes a MIA table and chair for the Vietnam veterans.
